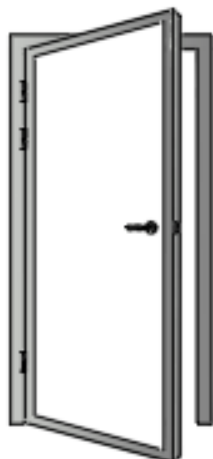


How to hand a door

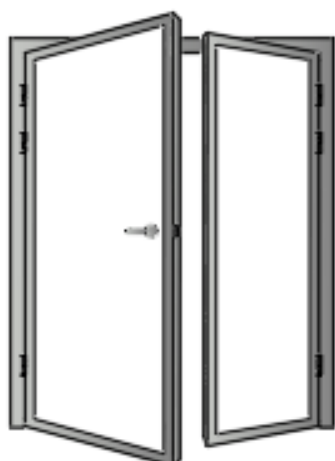


Left hand hung (LH or LHH)

Since our doors are often used internally it is open to interpretation describing handing as "Viewed from the outside", this is why we always hand our doors viewed from the "pull face" (in other words, ask yourself which side the hinges are on whilst opening the door toward yourself)



Right hand hung (RH or RHH)



Left hand active (LH or LHA)

Double leaf, or leaf and a half doors are handed the same. From the pull face look at which is the "Active" or "master" leaf

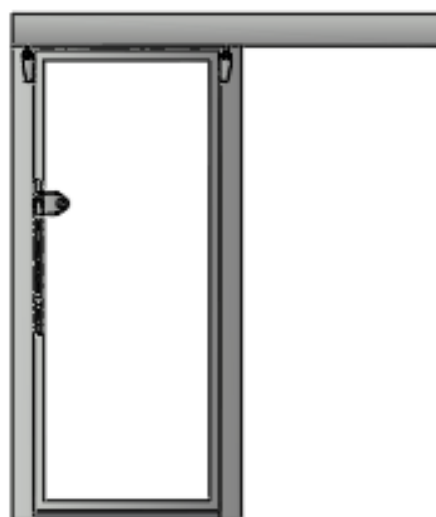


Right hand active (RH or RHA)

For sliding doors always stand on the side with the track and think of which way you need to slide the door to open it. Drawings show the door in the closed position.



Left hand slide (LH or LHS)



Right hand slide (RH or RHS)
